(1) Estimated by GU based on shared kitchen, private bath. Housing cost estimated at about 4,500 SEK/month (about \$465/month) in GU arranged housing. Also included in this estimate is allowance for purchase of food, books, phone, local travel, clothing, leisure, laundry, and miscellaneous local expenses.

Foreign citizens must be able to demonstrate that they can support themselves financially for the entire duration of their studies in Sweden by proving bank assets, scholarships, and other forms of support that provide at least 8,400 SEK/month.

The amounts listed under “Other Projected Expenses” are estimates and may increase or decrease due to exchange rate fluctuations and personal spending habits.
