### WOMEN'S MULTIRACIAL HISTORIES IN LONDON AND PARIS

Faculty-Led Study Abroad Tour with Dr. Janell Hobson (June 8-16, 2019)



**Day 1** *June 8, 2019* We will depart from JFK Airport in the morning, arriving in London in the evening and settling in our hotel accommodations.

Day 2 June 9, 2019

After breakfast in the hotel, we will embark on a bus tour of London and Windsor, where will visit the Windsor Castle and St.

George's Chapel, the site of the royal wedding of Prince Harry and Meghan Markle, the Duke and Duchess of Sussex.

We will end the day with a Welcome Dinner. \*Lunch on one's own.

#### **Day 3** June 10, 2019

After breakfast in the hotel, will visit Kenwood House just outside London. This is the historic home of Dido Elizabeth



Belle, the mixed-race woman from the eighteenth century raised in the aristocracy by her uncle, the Lord Chief Justice Mansfield. On our way back, we will stop at the Highgate Cemetery and visit the gravesite of Claudia Jones, right next to Karl Marx. \*Lunch and dinner on one's own.

### **Day 4** June 11, 2019

After breakfast in the hotel, we will embark on a morning workshop at the Black Cultural Archives in Brixton. After lunch on one's own, we will then visit the Rivington Place gallery. \*Dinner on one's own.

## Day 5 June 12, 2019 This will be a free day for you to explore London or beyond on your own.

### **Day 6** June 13, 2019

We will take the train from London to Paris and settle in our local accommodations with lunch on one's own. In the afternoon, we will visit the Musée D'Orsay, followed by a Seine River dinner cruise.

Day 7 June 14, 2019 We will take a bus tour guiding us throughout Paris, which will highlight all the different sites relating to black women's histories: from Sally Hemings to

Josephine Baker. The tour ends with a visit to the Louvre. \*Lunch included, but dinner on one's own.

# Day 8 June 15, 2019 This will be a free day to explore Paris or beyond, before partaking in a Farewell Dinner at the Khayma Rooftop at our hostel.

**Day 9** June 16, 2019 We will return to the states on a Paris flight returning to New York's JFK Airport.
