(1) Includes the DIS Comprehensive Housing Fee and the Danish Residence Permit fee (US\$300). DIS offers several housing options, including family stay, Kollegium or Folkehøjskole stay, or Danish roommates. A \$200 refundable housing damage deposit is required for all DIS-arranged housing. (2) Every SUNY student automatically receives a \$4,000 scholarship per semester which is deducted from the education abroad differential as shown. (3) Your place in the program is not ensured until DIS receives this non-refundable deposit. (4) There is a two week break each semester and a four week interim period between semesters during which students in homestays are expected to participate in study tours or to travel independently.
